



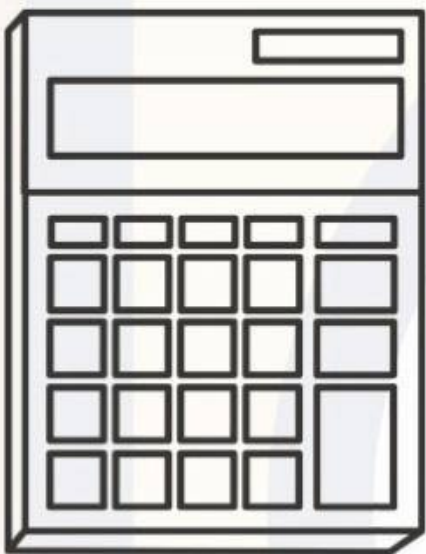

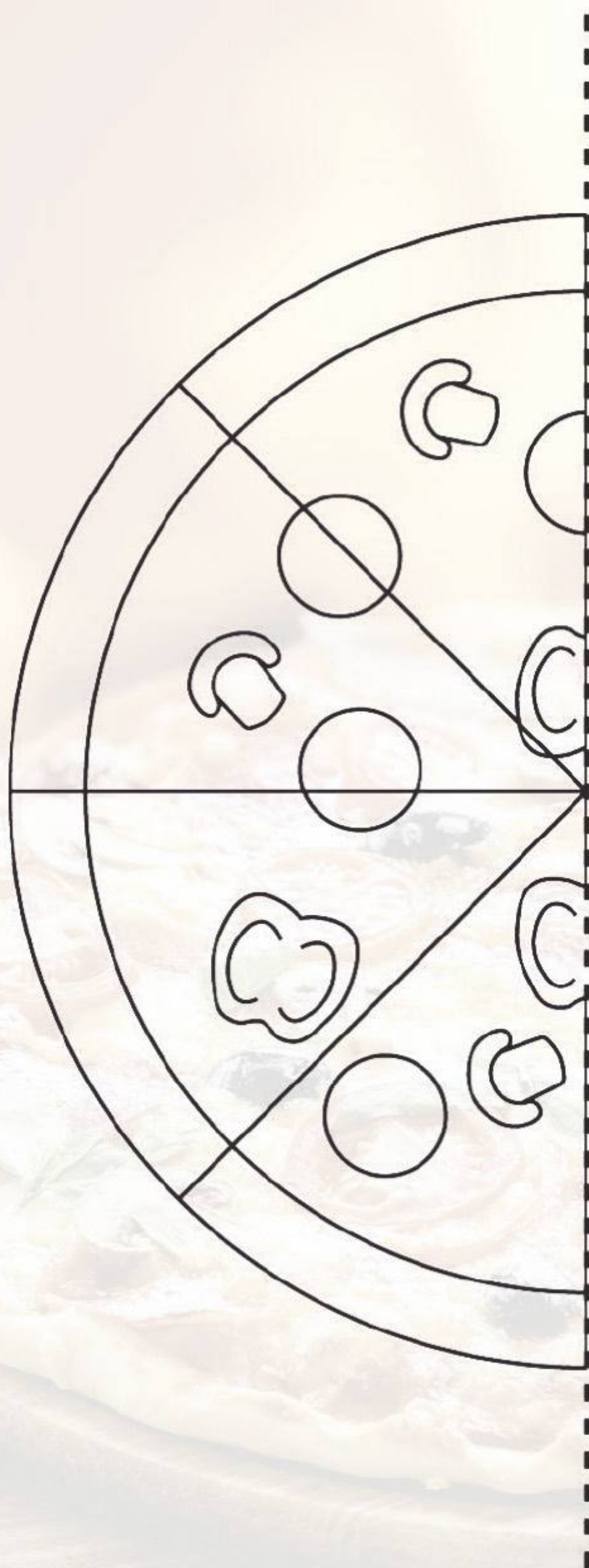

The Farmer And The Well



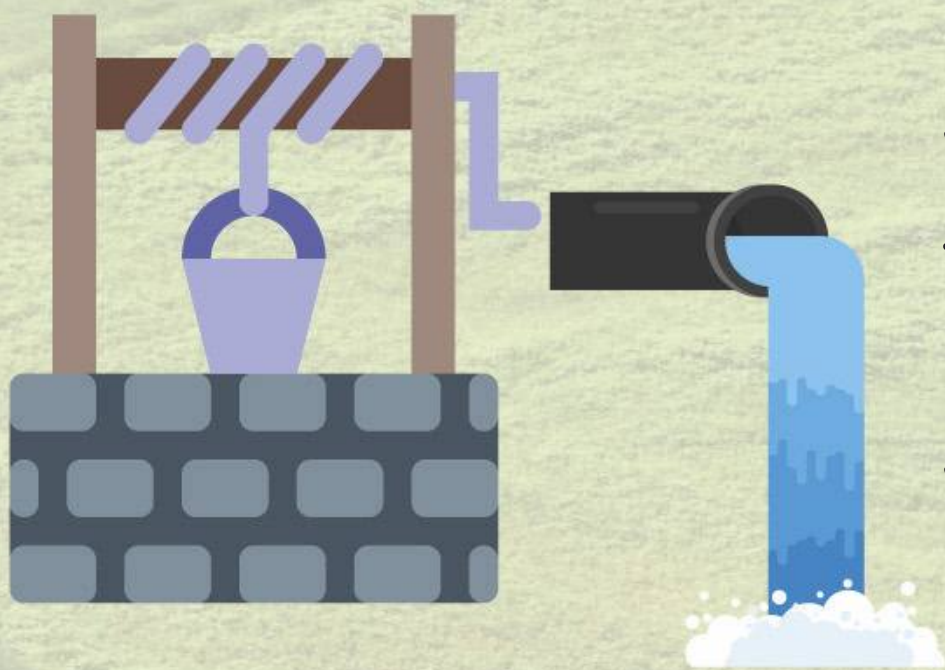
A farmer looking for a source of water for his farm bought a well from his neighbour. The neighbour was cunning, though, and refused to let the farmer take water from the well.

- Lay out a piece of string and start designing your heartstring, alternating hearts and buttons. You'll need two of each heart and button so you can glue them together on either side of the string.



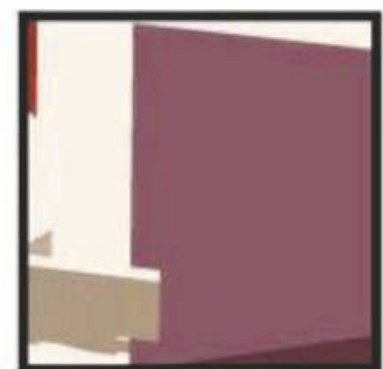
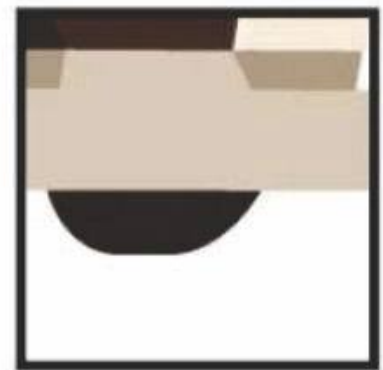
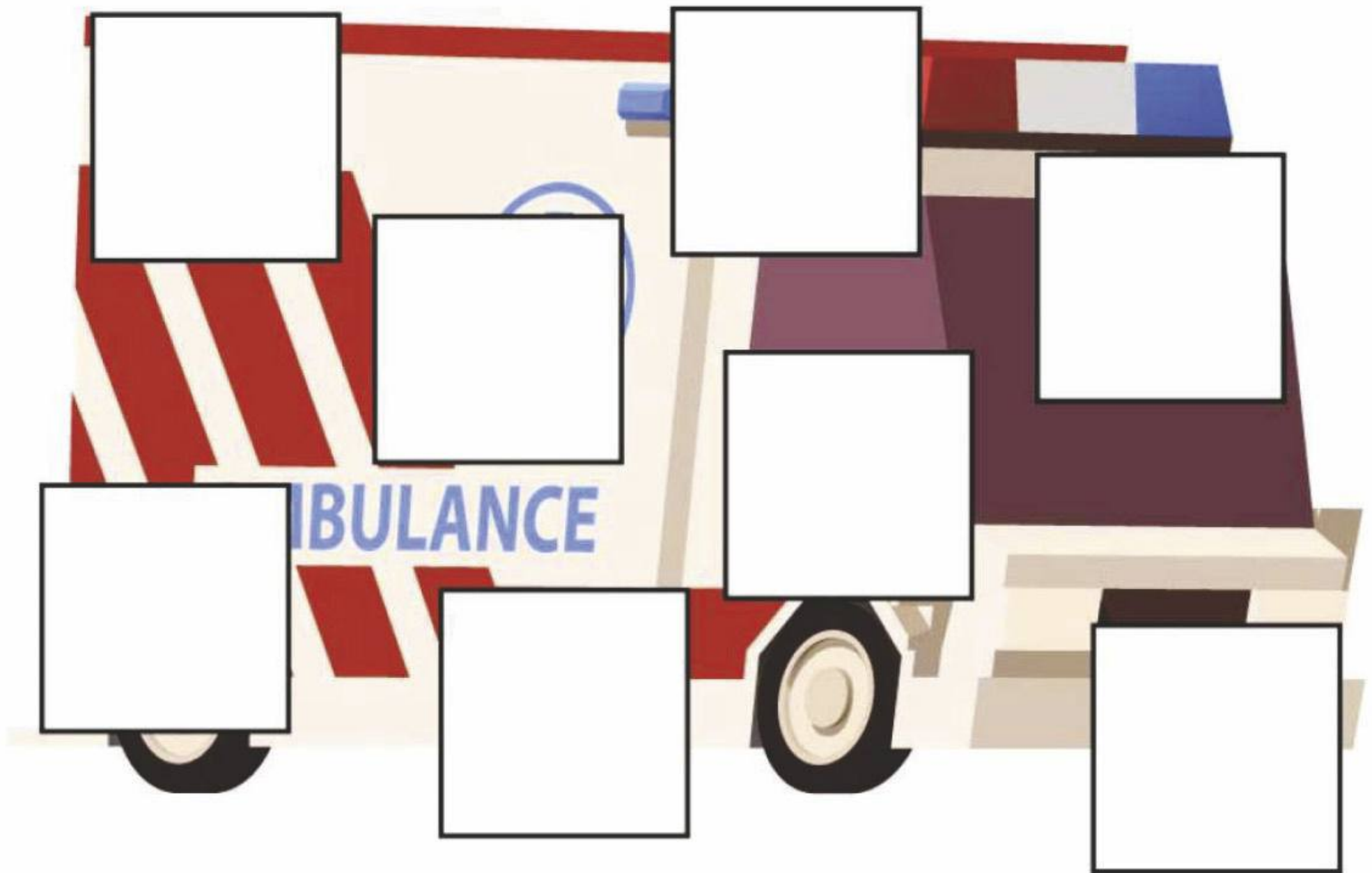
- Allow drying for a few minutes.

Get a good nail brush and ask your parents to scrub the dirt out from under your nails before bedtime.



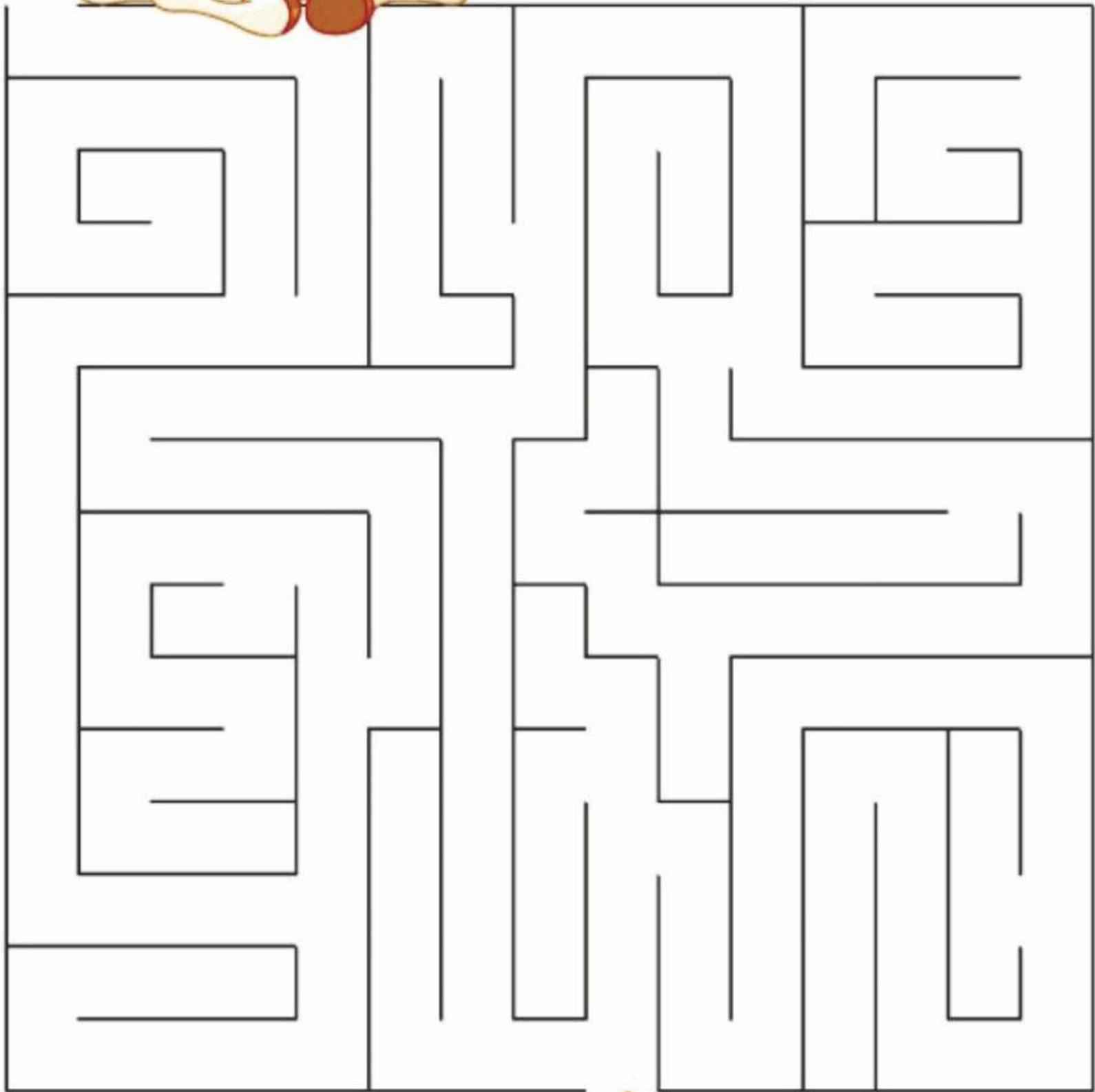
A weekly clipping will help get rid of dirt and reduce the possibility of painful ingrown nails.

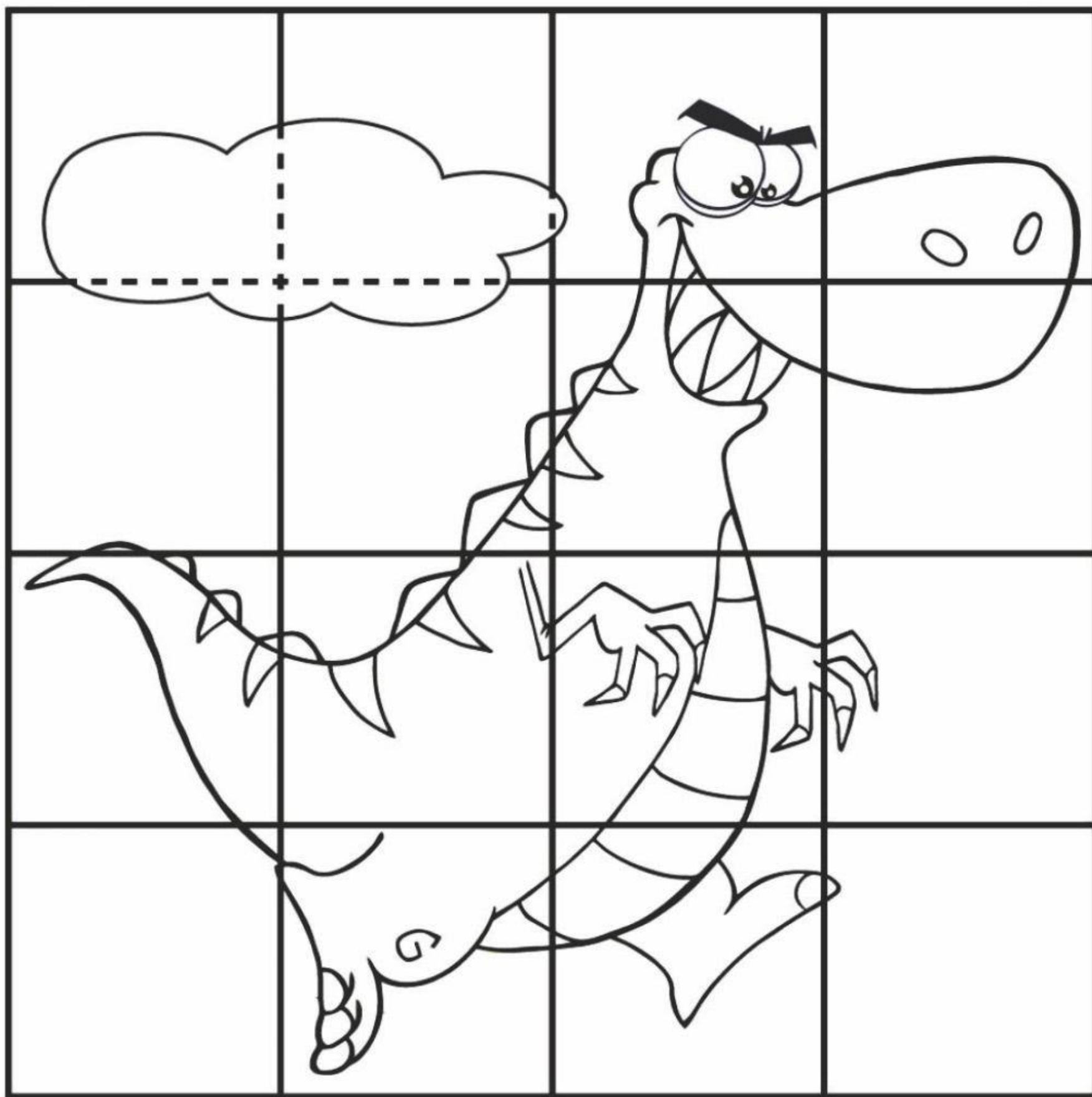

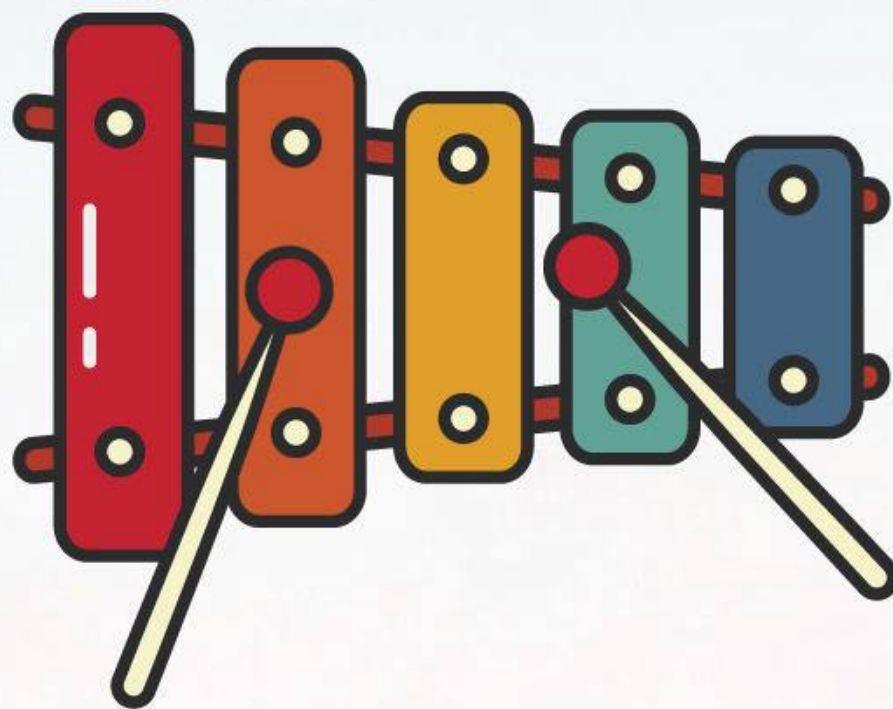

The Xylophone



A xylophone is a type of musical instrument. It has bars of different lengths arranged side by side. When a performer strikes the bars with a mallet or a stick, the bars produce sounds. Each bar is tuned to produce a particular note.

Xylophones may have come from Southeast Asia originally. Today they are common there and throughout Africa. In Europe, the xylophone has been used since about the 1500s. It was used at first for folk music.



A person who plays the Xylophone is called a xylophonist.

Electric Eel

The electric eel gets its name from its shocking abilities!



Once prey is found, electric eels will use a much stronger shock to stun prey, usually smaller fish. Electric eels can grow up to 8 feet (2.5 meters) in length.

Electric eels are nocturnal, live in muddy, dark waters, and have poor eyesight. So instead of using eyes, electric eels emit a weak electric signal, which they use like radar to navigate.

Electric Eel



Electric eels can produce two types of electric currents, low voltage and high voltage. Low voltage currents are used to sense the surroundings. High voltage currents are used to detect and stun the prey.

Despite their appearance, electric eels aren't actually eels at all! They are more closely related to carp and catfish. electric eels have special organs for generating electric current.

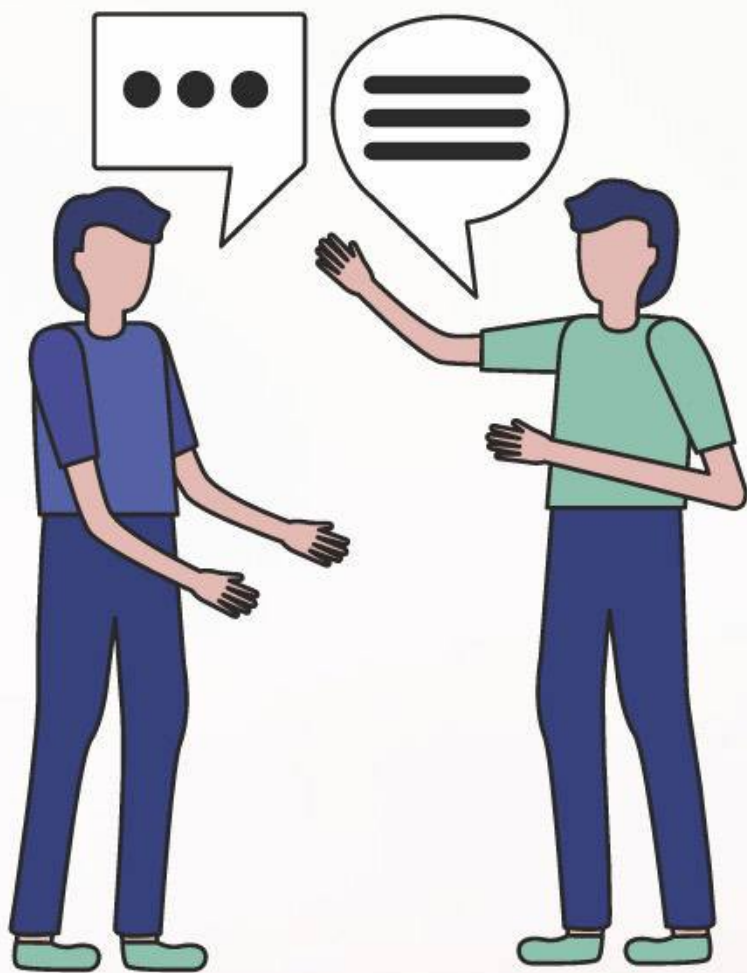


The Boasting Traveler

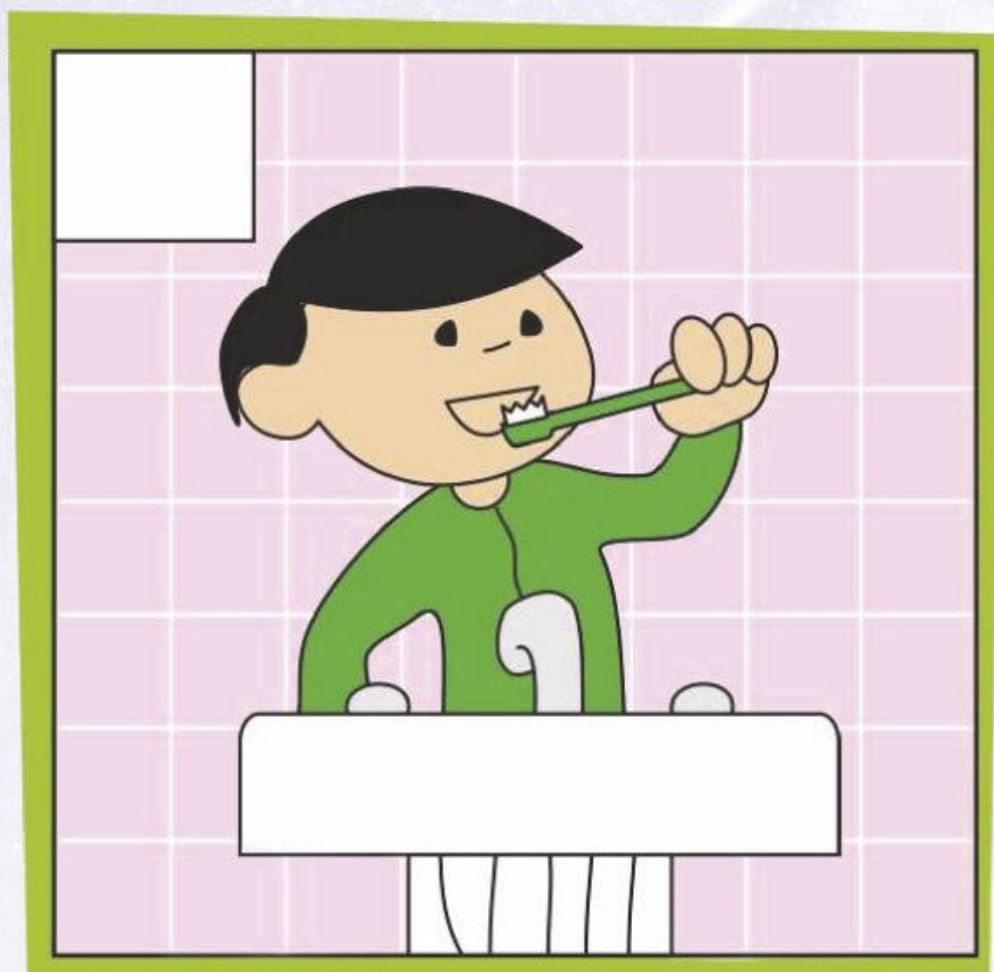
What can i do to save them?

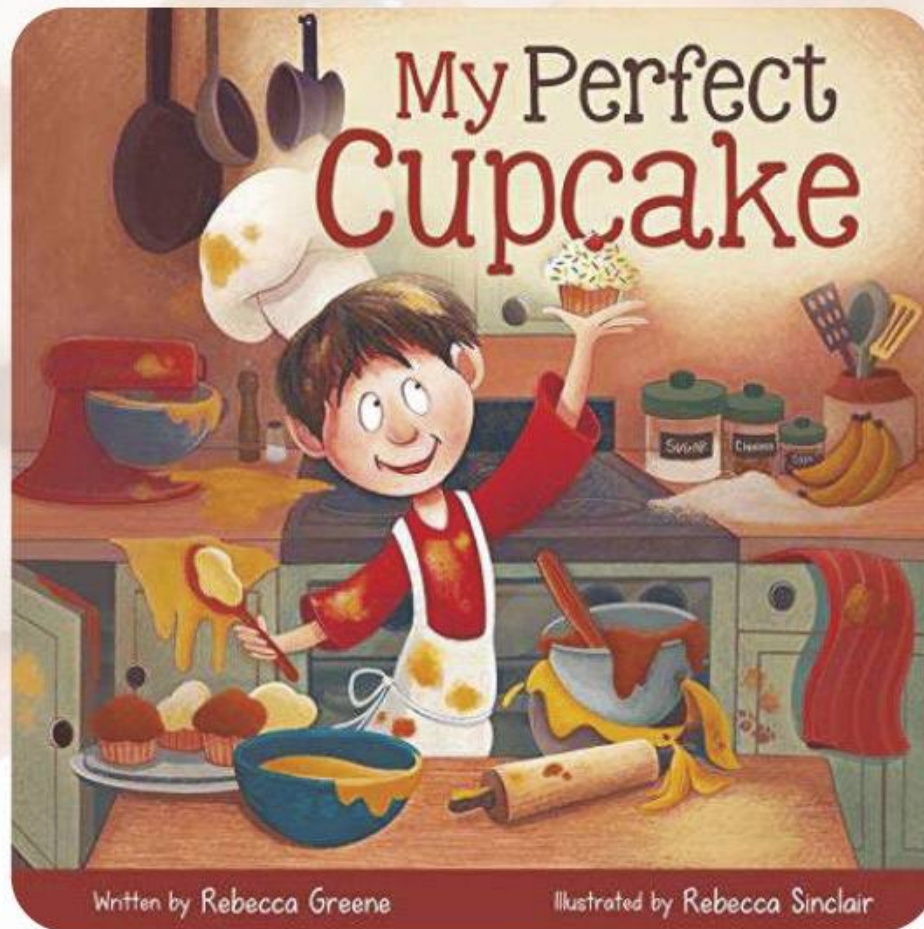
